The Confederated Tribes of Grand Ronde Emergency Management team is helping to put together the Grand Ronde CERT program and would like your help.

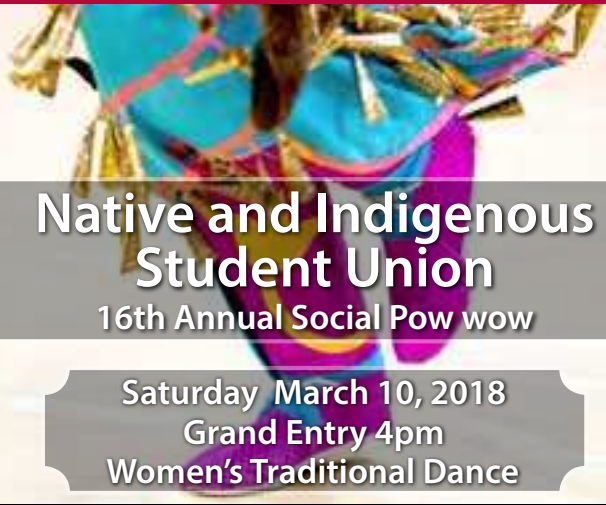
**Membership is needed!!**
