The photo will be used to illustrate the Grand Ronde Tribe entry in the *National Geographic* KIDS publication.

Propert said he found the photo online and wanted to use it to display the section on the Grand Ronde Tribe.

"I think *National Geographic* wanting to use one of Michelle Alaimo's photos speaks volumes about the professionalism and quality of her work. *National Geographic* is known for taking and using excellent photos," Rhodes said.
