For Who: Enrolled CTGR Tribal youth, CTGR Tribal descendant youth and other enrolled Native American students who are entering Kindergarten through 5th grade in the Willamina and Sheridan School Districts this fall (please note that we are limited to 10 youth from Sheridan due to transportation limitations)

Limited spaces available

K5 Afterschool roster spots are filled on a first come, first serve basis using a "Four Tier System," with 60 roster openings, (K/2: 30 spots & 3/5: 30 spots)

- * **Location** is at the CTGR Youth Education buildings
- * **Transportation** is provided on a CTGR bus from Willamina Elementary School. Due to van seating limitations, we can only serve 10 students from the Sheridan Elementary Schools (FCS and SJS).
- * **Provide** healthy afternoon snacks each day and a variety of educational, recreational, and cultural enrichment activities.
- * **Time** for K5 Afterschool is 3:45-5:15 p.m., plus a few full days throughout the year.
