Will grew up poor, but after Will and his father save Van Horne from an avalanche, Van Horne offers Will’s father a job to help him expand his great empire across to the Pacific by conducting the maiden excursion of The Boundless.

This new life of living in luxury soon gets muddled in a string of chance events and Will finds himself framed for a murder he didn’t commit. Will finds himself on the run, hiding out with a circus ensemble that is traveling on The Boundless’ first journey. Will meets Maren, a tightrope walker and escape artist. The elusive ringmaster and magician, Mr. Dorian, agrees to house Will in his first-class suite as long as Will helps him with a top secret assignment.

This book balances magic, action, a bit of romance and lots of adventure in one amazing story. If you are looking for a book that will keep you coming back for more, hanging on the edge of your seat and keep you in suspense at every turn, then I’d definitely recommend reading “The Boundless.” – *by Dylan Larson*

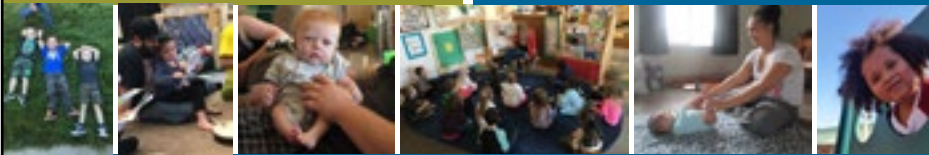
