Sweeney named Bureau of Indian Affairs director

WASHINGTON, D.C. – Tara MacLean Sweeney, an Alaskan leader and businesswoman with the Arctic Slope Regional Corp., has been sworn in as the assistant secretary for Indian Affairs in the Department of the Interior.

She was nominated by President Donald Trump in October 2017 and she will oversee Interior’s responsibilities regarding Native American Tribes in the United States.

Sweeney is a member of the Native village of Barrow, Alaska, and the Inupiat community of the Arctic slope. She becomes the first Alaskan and only the second woman to hold the position with the Department of the Interior.

“My goal is to develop strong relationships with Tribes, Alaska Native corporations and the Native Hawaiian organizations to work on innovative solutions for lifting up our communities. I am motivated to work with Indian Country to find efficiencies inside the Bureau of Indian Affairs, improve service delivery and culturally relevant curriculum in the Bureau of Indian Education, and create a more effective voice for Tribes through the federal government,” she said in a press release.

The Bureau of Indian Affairs provides services to 1.9 million Native American and Alaska Natives in 567 federally recognized Tribes and Alaska Native corporations. ■

2. Grand Ronde Tribal members
3. Spouse of a Grand Ronde Tribal member or
4. Parent or legal guardian of Grand Ronde Tribal member children

Internal recruitment process

For those individuals meeting minimum qualifications an interview will be given in the follow-

ing ranking order:

1. Grand Ronde Tribal members
 - a) Qualified Grand Ronde Tribal members who show they meet the minimum qualifications of the position during the course of the interview process will be given first consideration for hire and the recruitment process will end.
2. Tribal member spouses, parents and/or legal guardians of Grand Ronde Tribal member children and current regular employees.
