The drop box is for any prescribed or over-the-counter medication. If the containers are too large to fit in the drop box, please repackage them in a zip-lock plastic bag. Tribal Police employees cannot handle the medications so the person dropping them off must repackage them. Needles and liquids are not allowed in the drop box. The Clothes Closet is seeking school supplies and clean gently used backpacks.

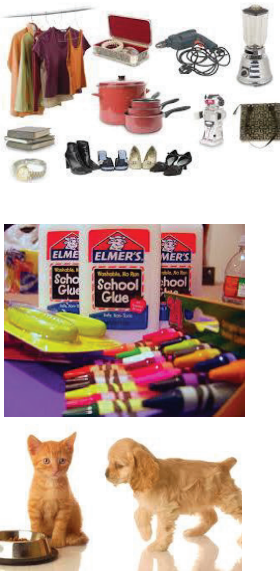
Empowerment Outreach is seeking camping equipment, bedding, sleeping bags (broken zipper ok) for homeless families.
