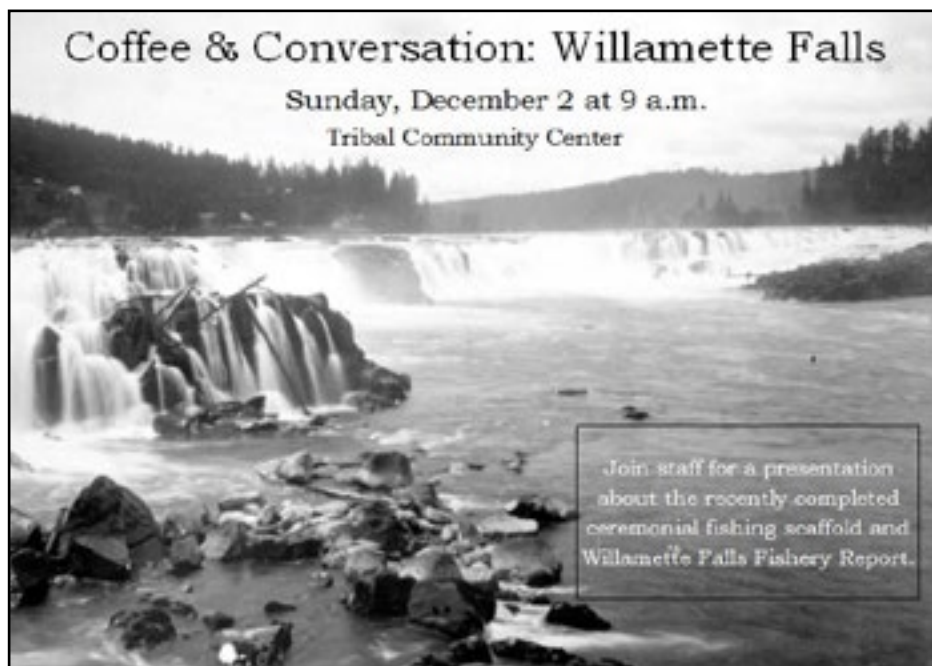

WIC visits Community Center monthly

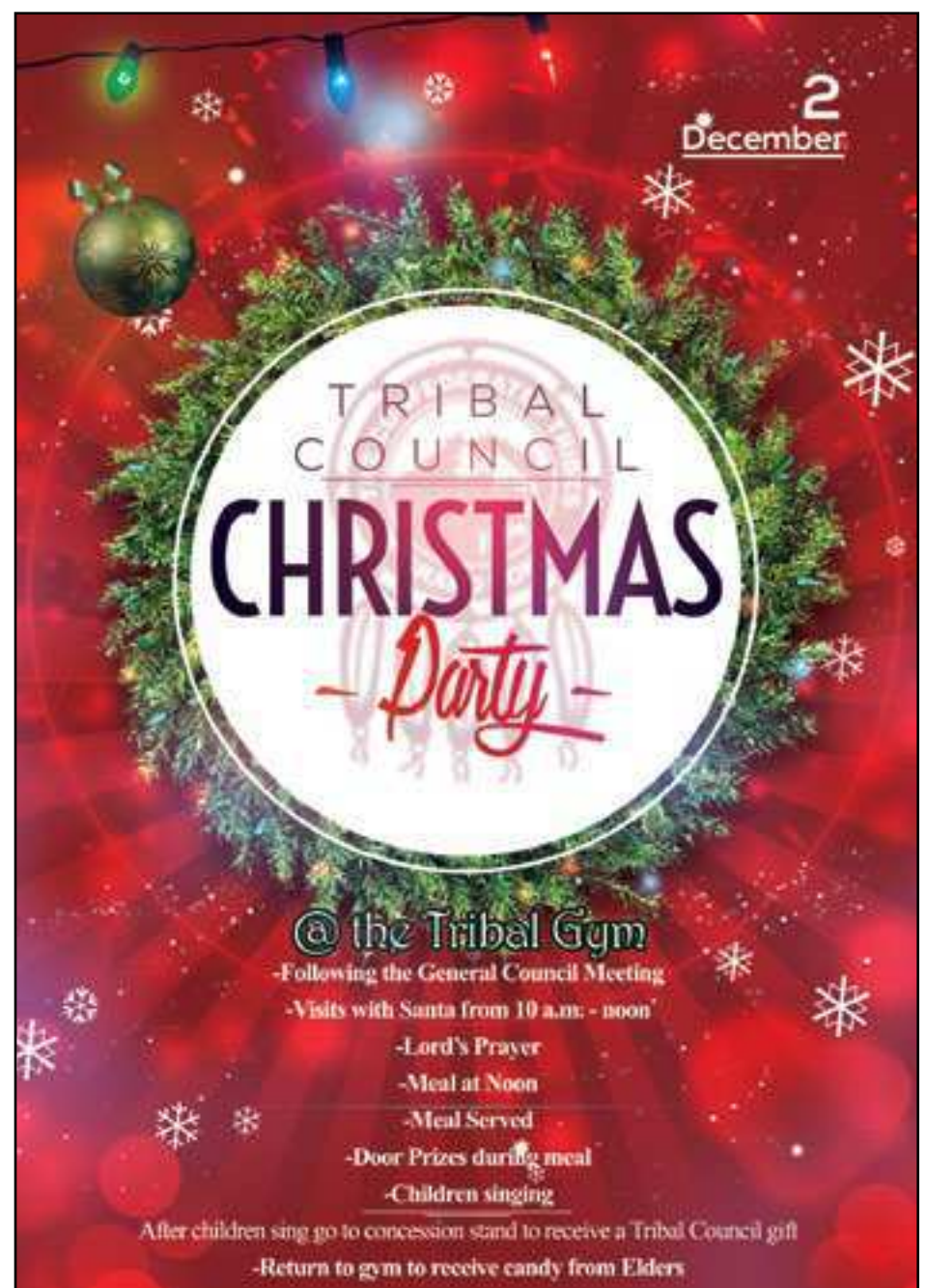
Pregnant? Breastfeeding? Does your family include a child under the age of 5?
