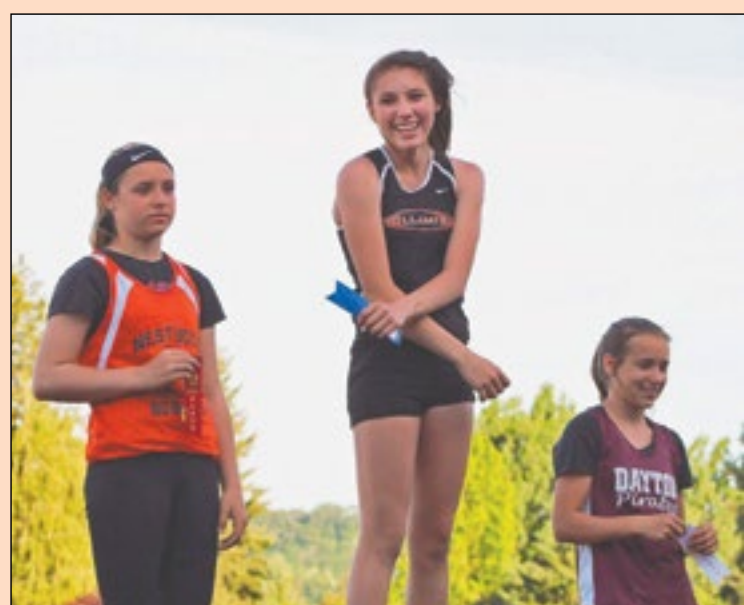
Track success

Willamina School District will provide free meals to children during the summer as it has for the last 22 years.

Each year, the U.S. Department of Agriculture partners with local organizations to provide free meals to children when school is out for the summer. Anyone aged 1 to 18 can eat for free with no income requirements or registration required.

The schedule will be:

- 11 to 11:45 a.m. Monday through Thursday at Willamina Elementary School between June 17 and July 25;
- Noon to 12:30 p.m. at Tina Miller Park from June 17 to Aug. 9;
- 1 to 1:30 p.m. at Raven Loop Park in Grand Ronde between June 17 to Aug. 9;
- And 11:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. at Willamina High School on June 24-25.
