Jackson and his family have fallen on hard times. There is no money for rent and little to no food in the house. Jackson fears they’ll probably have to live in their minivan again. That’s when Crenshaw, his old imaginary friend, returns to Jackson’s life. Crenshaw is a large, outspoken human-sized cat that walks on two legs.

This book touches on some tougher subjects, but is broken up with moments of light-heartedness. The author does a good job of making sure the book isn’t just about the hardships that Jackson and his family are going through. The book is also about friendship, even if it’s imaginary, and how friends help get you through the tough times.
