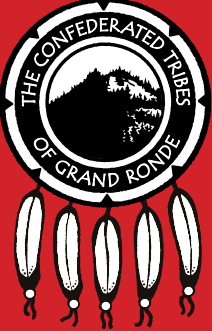

to include a 2,000-square-foot addition that would house Domestic Violence Program offices. Tribal Planning & Grants Manager Kim Rogers said the project was selected out of nine possible recommendations on the Tribal campus;

- Approved the agenda for the Sunday, Feb. 2, General Council meeting to be held at the Monarch Hotel & Convention Center in Clackamas. The program re-

port will be by the Grand Ronde Health & Wellness Center and a Community Input meeting will be held afterward;

- And approved 31 Restoration Roll corrections. In 2019, Tribal Council approved 204 corrections to the Restoration Roll. The corrections will now be sent to the Secretary of the Interior for approval.
