Based on the allegations set forth in the Petition for Name Change filed by Petitioner on April 8, 2020;

**THE COURT FINDS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. This Court has jurisdiction over the Petitioner and the subject matter of the Petition herein;
2. The Petitioner is over 18 years of age;
3. The Petitioner is an enrolled member of the Confederated Tribes of Grand Ronde Community of Oregon, roll number 6554;
4. The Petitioner has not petitioned and been granted a change of name by the Tribal Court within the past twelve (12) months;
5. The Petitioner has published a Notice of Name Change in the Tribal newspaper, Smoke Signals for one edition.
6. No hearing is required by Ordinance and no hearing occurred for this matter.

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:**

1. The name of the Petitioner is changed from Joseph Bertinchamps Jackson to Frank Craig Bertinchamps;
2. The Clerk of the Tribal Court shall cause a copy of this Order to be published in the Tribal Newsletter;
3. The Clerk of the Tribal Court shall submit a certified copy of this Order to the Grand Ronde Tribal Enrollment office;
4. The Clerk of the Court shall provide a certified copy of the Order to the Oregon State Department of Vital Statistics.

### Opportunity for comment on Grand Ronde Housing Department CARES Act 2020 Indian Housing Plan (IHP)

Under the Native American Housing Assistance and Self-Determination Act (NAHASDA) of 1996, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) will provide grants to Indian Tribes/Indian Housing Authorities for the development and operation of low-income housing in Indian areas. Grants are made to eligible recipients under the Indian Housing Block Grant Program. To be eligible for the grants, respondents must submit an Indian Housing Plan that meets the minimum requirements of the Act, and also submit an Annual Performance Report to HUD and maintain records for HUD monitoring. The Grand Ronde Housing Department (GRHD) has received multiple grants under this program that were active during 2019. **Comments on the 2020 CARES Act Indian Housing Plan are welcome and copies of this report can be obtained at the GRHD office or by calling 503-879-2401 or 1-800-422-0232, ext. 2401. Comments must be submitted in writing to GRHD no later than 5 p.m. Monday, June 29, 2020.** All comments will be incorporated into the final report submitted to HUD.
