For the first time since 2015, eulachon smelt returned to the Sandy River in large enough numbers the Oregon Department of Fish & Wildlife opened up harvesting for one day on Thursday, March 30. Grand Ronde Aquatic Biologist Brandon Weems says smelt served as a significant food source for Tribal people.
