Tribal banking partner affected by merger

In March, Tribal banking partner Columbia Bank merged with Umpqua Bank and is now doing business under the Umpqua name.

Effective March 20, their banking systems merged and any Tribal member automatic deposits that would have said Columbia Bank now will say Umpqua Bank.

“You should not see any other significant changes,” Treasury Manager DeAnne Norton said. ■
