Who Is This Program For?
Tribal member youth between the ages of 14-18 at the time employment starts and will be enrolled in the 9-12 grades for the 2023-2024 school year.

Program Requirements:

- Complete application online (also provide two forms of identification)
- Complete interview process
- Complete onboarding process
- Attend orientation (first day of work)
- Attend 4 mandatory Professional Development trainings (dates, times, location TBD)
- Complete Exit 500-word essay of work experience at end of Internship

When Will Internship Positions Start/End?
Starts as early as June 5
Ends as late as August 18

When Will I Be Notified for the Job That I Have Applied For?
Once the application has been received, a follow up email will be sent with key information and next steps

What Types Of Internships Will Be Offered?
There will be a limited number of Internships at various CTGR departments. You are encouraged to apply for more than one position. Tribal department and job positions will be posted on April 7th on the [Tribal employment website](#). Please note: some positions may require a minimum age requirement.
