Beware of scammers, chief warns

Summer has arrived early in Grand Ronde and so have the prank phone calls.

Tribal Police Chief Jake McKnight sent out an all-employee e-mail on Tuesday, May 16, to inform employees of a few disturbing incidents.

“It was brought to our attention yesterday that there was a prank call to one of our Tribal departments asking the employee to come out with their hands up,” he said. “I just wanted to make everyone aware that in most situations an officer would never call and ask you to come out with your hands up.”

Tribal Police also have been told by community members that people are getting phone calls saying that a loved one is being held hostage and will be harmed if a ransom isn't paid.

“If you receive one of these calls, do not pay them or give them any of your personal information,” McKnight said. “You need to call your local police department right away.”
