A representative from Robert W. Baird & Co. Inc. briefed the general membership on the Grand Ronde Tribe's investment portfolio during the hybrid General Council meeting held Sunday, Oct. 1, on Zoom and in Tribal Council Chambers.

The 30-minute briefing was presented in executive session, which limits how much *Smoke Signals* can report on the content.

Baird Director Joseph Hoon made the presentation and there were no questions or comments from the membership during the session.
