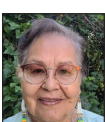

ADVISORY QUESTIONS

QUESTION #1

Vote For No More Than One (1)

Are you or a member of your household experiencing food insecurity?

EXPLANATION - A yes vote will indicate to the Tribe that you or a member of your household are experiencing food insecurity. This information will be used to see how the Tribe can help connect Tribal members with local resources and will also help inform the prioritization of programs and services aimed at reducing food insecurity.

QUESTION #2

Vote For No More Than One (1)

If the Tribe is operating on a "hold the line" budget, should the Tribe continue to put out advisory votes that have budgetary impacts?

EXPLANATION - A yes vote would mean that when the Tribe is operating on a "hold the line budget" (where the Tribe will not be spending additional money until additional revenues are identified) that you would like the Tribe to continue putting out advisory votes for Tribal members to vote on that have budgetary impacts.

Should the Tribe look into helping Tribal members access legal aid services?

EXPLANATION - A yes vote would result in the Tribe looking at ways it could help facilitate Legal Aid Services for Tribal members. Legal Aid Services are typically available to disadvantaged communities and include but are not limited to, assistance with government assistance programs like SSI, other public benefits, housing problems, consumer problems, and family and senior law problems.
