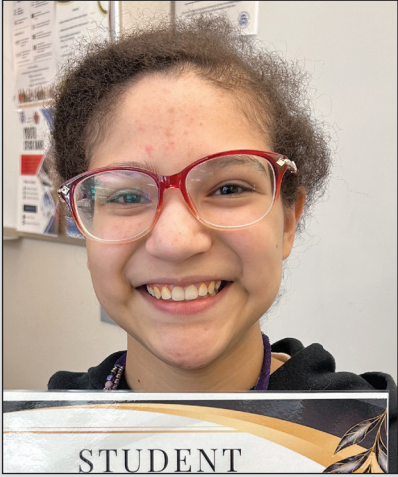


Students of the month

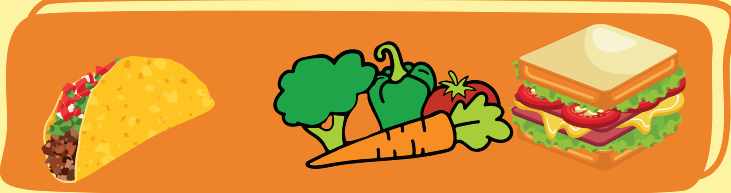
