EDITORIAL.

Kuropatkin must supply the home government at St. Petersburg with something in the way of war news, and being hard pressed for anything better with which to console those anxious to hear encouraging news from the front, he has settled down to the stereotyped phrase, "The Russian forces retired in good order having discovered that the Japanese were superior in numbers."

Making Bricks.

Judge Schroeder was down from Annapolis Saturday, and reports operations of the new brickyard progressing nicely. They have one hundred thousand bricks on the yard.

Big Battle Progressing.

St. Petersburg, Aug. 1.—A big battle in progress at Haicheng. General Count Keller, commanding the forces in action, was killed by a bursting shell.

London, Aug. 1.—Reuters has a dispatch asserting that Kuropatkin's east front or right flank has been turned by the Japanese.

St. Petersburg, Aug. 1.—Kuropatkin reports: "The Japanese armies simultaneously renewed their advance on our southern front. Our rear guard offered a stubborn resistance until the attacks of the enemy revealed that they were of a greatly superior force. The rear guards slowly retired in the direction of Haicheng."

"The Russian division near Simnangcheng successfully checked a force of the enemy which pressed toward our right flank."

"The Japanese main blow was delivered by the Taku Shan army, Oku commanding, between Siquanqung and Haicheng."

Yinkow, Aug. 1.—Considerable forces of Japanese have been landed under the cover of warships.
