Coos and Curry County Exchanges.

From the Sentinel. The receipts of the Coquille post office for the quarter ending December 31, was nearly \$11,000.

Messrs Freund and Spenser of Portland passed through this city last week for Langlois. These gentlemen are interested in the oil well at that place.

Frank Burkholder has sold to Mrs. Georgia K. Robinson lots 14 to 18, block 20, Portland addition to Bandon.

W. H. Norval returned yesterday from Portland where he has been for several weeks visiting his family and transacting business.

The city has nearly completed the new wharf which is a great improvement over the old wharf that has been an eye-sore for so many years.

A number of Republicans of this city met at W. C. Chase's Wednesday evening and held a short meeting and it was decided to call an adjourned meeting at the court house on Monday evening, Jan. 20. It is hoped that all Republicans will make it an object to come out and help organize for the coming campaign.

The Randolph Lumber Co. of Aberdeen are cutting out ship timbers for Kruse & Banks, ship-builders of Marshfield for the new schooner Fishfield which they are building.

D. H. Jackson, who has been clerking for the Mill Store for the past several months, has returned to his home in Bandon. Mr. Jackson has purchased a half interest in the J. H. Cope ranch near Four-mile.

The Coquille Valley Fruit Grower's Association will meet at Myrtle Point the first Wednesday in February. It is expected that the state fruit inspector will be in attendance at that time and will make his appointment of an inspector.

At eight o'clock sharp, Friday evening, Jan. 24, the preliminary debate for the purpose of determining who shall represent our high school in the contest with Bandon, will be held at the high school room. A large number have volunteered to enter this try-out, and a spirited debate is anticipated. Three judges will decide the debate between the two sides, and five judges will select the three speakers against Bandon.

The Coquille city council has appointed a committee to draft a new charter for the city to be submitted to the voters at the next regular city election.

Northern Pacific will be built to Coos Bay before the drain extension of the Southern Pacific. The view of an early extension of the Northern Pacific down the coast is likewise held at Astoria, Coos Bay Harbor, (North Bend).
