### Port Orford Notes.

From the Tribune.

The Adolphsen mill will soon have the lumber sawed for Hume's Cold Storage plant at Port Orford, which our people hope will be completed in time for the fall run of salmon on Elk and Sixes river.

The little daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Alf Gauntlett at Gold Beach, still clings to life without any apparent change, her mind still a blank, and the little body emaciated. It is over 80 days since the little girl was attacked by meningitis, and the case is remarkable as it is said this disease usually terminates in 60 days.

A letter of March 10th from Mrs. Knapp, from Los Angeles, to Mr. Knapp, states that the trial of the P. F. & L. Co. Land Fraud cases would likely begin the next day. The Curry county people were all well excepting Mr. Hurst, who was quite sick. Mrs. Roby, who was well known at Port Orford was there.

The Coquille Herald contains the following interesting matter in regard to the Coquille Valley Power Co:

The projectors are local people who have formed a corporation with the following named as its officers: E. F. Davenport, Pres.; C. C. Carter, Vice-Pres.; B. E. Hendricks, Sec.; Directors, J. R. Benson, C. C. Carter, E. F. Davenport, B. F. Henderson and D. H. Johnson. Preliminary work is now in progress on the immense water power plant which is to be established at the N. Harry place on the East Fork. All surveys have been made and this plant will not cost nearly as much as the average plant, in accordance to the amount of power developed.

The capital stock of the corporation is \$50,000, divided into shares of \$100 each, a considerable quantity of which has been taken.

Figures show that at least 3,000 horsepower can be developed, and it is thought that it will be possible to reach 4,000 horsepower.

The water is to be piped a distance 5,000 feet from the reservoir which will be the source of supply to the power station, at which point it will have a fall of 3000 feet. The power will be transmitted from the power station to Myrtle Point, Coquille, Marshfield, North Bend and Bandon by electricity, thus giving these towns the advantage of a 24-hours-a-day

power service that will do more to develop manufacturing industries than anything that could be introduced. Only a limited amount of stock will be sold, but that is going rapidly at par.

It seems impossible to get ahead of those Bandon fellows. In the window of Smith's Cafe there is a large piece of whalebone with a card attached stating that it was taken from a Coos Bay smelt. Jim Mars of Bandon was passing by with L. D. Pettyjohn, and L. D. called his attention to it as an evidence of the remarkable products of Coos Bay when such a large whale bone could be found in a smelt. Jim looked at it a moment and then turned up his nose in contempt.

"Huh!" he said, "that's nothing. Why, I found a sardine on the beach at Bandon that had a piece of whalebone twice the size of that!" And Mars grew so cheery at the superiority of Bandon that Pettyjohn had to hold him down to keep him from floating off into the atmosphere.—Coos Bay Times.

Bandon Prosperous.—M. A. Sweetman returned last night from Bandon where he has spent several days on business. He states that the town is enjoying an unusually prosperous spring, much building being underway. Everyone there is enthusiastic over the proposed paper and pulp mill which, they expect, will be built soon.—Coos Bay Times.

It has been announced that A. M. Simpson has given an option on quite a tract of timber land in the Coquille valley to C. R. Smith, representing the Menasha Woodware Company of Wisconsin. The latter concern is figuring on putting in a new factory here.—Coos Bay Times.
