Newport, Or.-The steam Schr. Minnie E. Kenton, running from Aberdeen to San Francisco, Captain McKenna, met with disaster during the severe storm Friday night. The deck load shifted and strained the vessel so that she sprung a leak. On Saturday, a big wave struck the vessel, washed the deck load and cabin overboard, leaving the vessel waterlogged and unmanageable and, the deck awash.

Eleven of the crew were drowned while attempting to launch' a boat Four succeeded in getting out on a raft and endeavored to reach the shore near Otter Rock; fifteen miles rom here. . Three of the men washed overboard and the survivor sustained a broken leg.
