### Jerome Drops Thaw Case

White Plains, N. Y. Sept. 26 —Justice Mills today denied the application of Harry K. Thaw for a jury trial to determine whether or not Thaw is sane, but promised to give Thaw a hearing before himself, Justice Mills. The date was to be fixed by counsel. Charles Morschauser, of Poughkeepsie, appeared in support of the motion, and District Attorney Jerome of New York opposed it.

Justice Mills set the hearing of Thaw's habeas corpus petition for Monday October 5th.

After Justice Mills had refused to transfer the case to New York county, District Attorney Jerome announced his withdrawal from the case. He said the financial condition of his office would not justify him in incurring the expense of continuing in the case in any other county than his own.
