OUR RELATIONS WITH SPAIN.

A few days ago President McKinley prepared a message concerning the relations towards Spain and Cuba which it was announced would be sent to congress Monday. It is said a resolution will be passed speedily, confined to simple intervention leaving the question of independence to be determined by subsequent action of congress.

THE PORT OF WEI-HAI-WEI.

It was semi-officially announced today that Great Britain had made arrangements with China to take over the port of Wei-hai-wei, on the Shantung peninsula, when the Chinese Government has paid the war indemnity due to Japan and the Japanese troops have evacuated the place.

Mrs. Rorer Prescribes the Best Food for Breakfast, Dinner and Supper.

Mrs. S. T. Rorer, writing on "The Best Food for a Growing Child" in the April Ladies' Home Journal, says: "A child must have in its active life at least two-thirds carbonaceous foods and one-third nitrogenous or flesh-building foods. For breakfast he may have a well-baked or steamed apple, a little apple sauce, a ripe peach or some grapes, followed by a well-cooked cereal with milk, after which a soft-boiled egg, a small bit of broiled white-fish, a little broiled sweet-bread, a piece of broiled chicken, or he may take simply a bowl of oatmeal or wheat preparation, and a slice of well-toasted whole wheat bread.

FISHERMEN'S MEETING.

The Price Will Be 4 Cents—Sand Island Trap Spiles Ordered Out. At the meeting of the Fishermen's Protective union last night the committee appointed at the last meeting to wait on the cannerymen to ascertain the price of salmon the coming season reported that the cannerymen agreed to pay 4 cents per pound, and that this price would be paid as long as the market justified it.
