Advices from Madrid say Senor Sagasta and his colleagues are greatly concerned regarding the demands of the United States government which they not only refuse to assume any of Spain's colonial debts, but wants to take the heavy artillery in Cuba and the floating dock recently sent to Havana.

The American commissioners have notified the Spanish authorities in Havana that the United States will assume control, military and governmental, of Cuba December 1st.
