TOWN ORDINANCE NO 26.

An Ordinance providing for building a sidewalk on the south side of Second Wm Safley and family are now living street and on the west side of Madison

street in the town of Florence. Section 1. The Town of Florence does ordain as follows: That it be and is after spending several weeks at his hop- hereby ordained and directed that a sidewalk shall be built on the South Ludvig Christensen took a lesson in side of Second street from the West side the mysteries of Old Fellowship of Washington to the East side of Quincy street. Also that a sidewalk shall be built on the west side of Madistreet to the south side of Fifth street.

Said sidewalk shall be built so as to be about level and about six inches from the ground, and to be made as follows. Six feet wide, three stringers 2x6; nails not less than 30 penny, wire; six nails to each plank; planks not wider than 12 inches, not less than 2 inches thick and of good sound lumber.

Section 2. The cost of building the sidewalks shall be paid by the lots fronting on said walks; the corner lots shall corner of such lot out into the street a Frank Evans who had change of the distance equal to the width of said walk; shall be paid for out of the general fund

Section 3. The building of said walk shall be done by property owners and if not done in ten days said sidewalks shall be let by the Board of Irustees of the town of Florence on contract or contracts to the lowest responsible bidder reserving the right to reject any and all bids. The building of said sidewalks. street and alley crossings shall be completed within 30 days from the passing of this ordinance.

Section 4. All cross walks and alley crossings shall be built as provided by Ordinance No 18 except that all crossings shall be six feet wide on top.
