

MARRIAGE OF OFFICERS.

The Armies of Europe Have Various Rules Regulating It.

The restrictive conditions at present in force with regard to the marriage of officers in the Russian army forbid this privilege under any circumstance in the case of officers under the age of 23. Bedot of an officer's wife must amount to a sum representing the minimum income of 250 rubles yearly.

The Italian army regulations, which fix the income of the fiancee at a minidium of from 1,200 to 2,000 lire, would appear to be more rational in their operation.
