WASHINGTON LETTER.

WASHINGTON, Feb. 25, 1901. An extra session being now considered certain, notwithstanding the eleventh hour efforts in the senate to prevent it, the leaders of the majority are considering plans to make it a short one...

ORDINANCE NO. 27. An Ordinance to forbid keeping or setting up any house of ill-fame, brothel or bawdy house in the Town of Florence...

SECTION 1. It shall not be lawful for any person or persons to keep or set up, within the limits of the Town of Florence, any house of ill-fame, brothel, or bawdy house for any purpose whatsoever.

SECTION 2. Any person or persons who shall keep or set up, within the limits of the Town of Florence, any house of ill-fame, brothel, or bawdy house...

SECTION 3. Any person who shall be an inmate of a house of ill-fame, brothel, or bawdy house within the limits of the Town of Florence, shall, upon conviction thereof...

SECTION 4. In all prosecutions for violation of this Ordinance, common fame shall be competent evidence in support of the charge.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect on the 1st day of March, 1901, and its approval by the president and publication in a newspaper for ten days.
