ANOTHER DOUGLAS MURDER Killed His Wife and Her Son Near Roseburg.

Roseburg, Sept. 10.—Mrs. Helene Beckman, about 43 years old, and her son Robert Ring, aged about 21 years, were murdered by W. F. Beckman, husband and step father, at their farm, 10 miles east of Roseburg, at 6:30 a. m. today.

Beckman had risen and was preparing breakfast. She had aroused her 13-year-old daughter, who, with another little girl, one of the McGees, was on the hillside, playing. The children heard the shots fired and ran toward the house.

Beckman, who was out in the yard, near the house, after an ax and wedge, to go in the woods to cut rails, put his coat and ax near the fence. It is supposed he heard the shot in the house and was going there. When within 10 feet of the house, he was shot in the breast, falling upon his face.

The neighbors hastened to the house and found Robert dead where he had fallen in the yard. On entering the house, they found Mrs. Beckman sitting on the floor dead, having been shot in the back.

Beckman, after the shooting, went to a neighbor's, near by, and told the man what he had done, and said he was going to kill himself.
