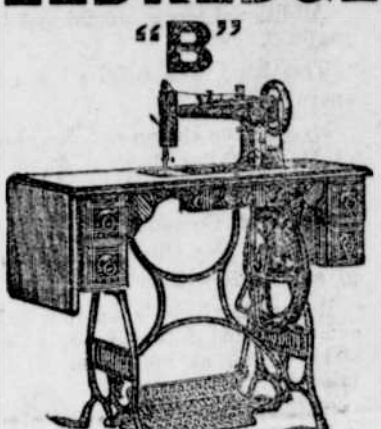

Five Farms of the Upper Coquille.

During a recent visit to the upper portion of the South Fork of the Coquille we were greatly impressed with many of the splendid farms and stock ranches of that section.

Mr. Hayes insists that his land is not quite so rich as is the soil of the lower river, but when he showed us three large bins of rice, clean wheat and oats, all raised on the place, we were a little skeptical as to the correctness of his estimate of the soil.

The next farm below that invited our attention was that of Mr. Wagener. This is one of the best cultivated farms in the upper valley.

Just across the river and a little below Mr. Wagener's farm, lies that of Mr. Morris. This place occupies a level prairie of some one hundred and fifty or two hundred acres, and is a beautiful tract of farmland.

Directly across the river, and east of Mr. Morris' place, is the farm and stock ranch of Mr. Gant. It is composed of a large body of prairie land lying in the valley and extending far up on the hills and is an excellent stock farm.
