ABOUT COOS COUNTY'S TAXES.

Why the Assessments Are Lower this Year than Last and Taxes Higher.

The Coast Mail Knows the Why, But Prefers to Receive for Partisan Ends.

ASAGO, Or., May 6, 1896. ED. HERALD: I have had numerous requests to explain why the tax levy for 1896 is higher than it was for 1895.

It appears from that statement that the assessment upon which the tax levy for the year 1896 was made is \$503,045 less than the assessment for 1895.

A just comparison would however be to first deduct the \$3500 for expenses of election and tax litigation from the levy for 1896, and the result will show that the tax levy for 1896 is comparatively \$8651.72, or more than one-fifth less than for 1895 for county purposes.

Had the taxable property upon which the levy for 1896 was made been the same as for 1895, and the levy for state and school purposes been the same, and we had had no tax litigation, the levy would have been about 17 mills instead of 22 mills.

The foregoing is a plain statement of facts, and it appears to me that any intelligent person can see that the increase in the levy is due to the state tax and the school tax, \$3500, which we did not have last year, so that comparatively the levy for county purposes is \$8651.72, or one-fifth less than for 1895.

Over this the county court has no control, and had the conditions this year been the same as in 1895 a levy of 18 mills would have been sufficient for state, school and county purposes.

Although your taxable property is less, you pay proportionately more tax on account of the raise in the levy for state and school purposes. It is certainly very plain that while the levy for county purposes has been decreased by 12.8 per cent, the state board's levy has been increased 36.4 per cent, and the school tax increased 3.8 per cent.

The foregoing is respectfully submitted to the Coast Mail. In a recent issue that paper blamed the Populists of Coos county for the increase in the taxes.

The profligate "Republican legislature" of 1895 deserves the credit, not the Populists of Coos county. The tax litigation is another subject upon which the people want an explanation, although this matter has also been explained in a recent issue of the HERALD.

In all the tax cases against the corporations Judge J. C. Fullerton has stayed proceedings, or in other words has enjoined the county from collecting the taxes due. They are now all pending in the supreme court, and hence the county officials can do nothing in the matter until said court renders its decision.

There are several important points involved in these cases, and when a decision is rendered the taxpayer will have a better understanding of his obligation to the people, and we expect and hope that thereafter future administrations will be avoided the unpleasantness, annoyance and expense of such litigation.

The county court has petitioned the supreme court to advance these cases on their docket so that they may all be heard at the same sitting, that we may have an early decision, and that we may have an early decision, and that we may have an early decision.
