In the matter of the petition for locating a county road in Coos county, Oregon, beginning on the E bank of the S Fork of Coquille river, on the E and W line in N side of Tp 30, S of R 12 W, thence to cross river and run on the nearest and most practicable route until it strikes the river bank at or near the north and south line on E side of lot 2 Sec. 5 in Tp 30, S of R 12 W, thence to follow up the river bank to a suitable place for a ford, thence to cross the river and intersect the present county road in lot 1, Sec. 5, Tp 30, S of R 12 W and there terminate; petition granted.

Boundary of R D No 20 changed so as not to include any land on the S side of Middle Fork of Coquille river; the portion cut off being ded to R D No 4.

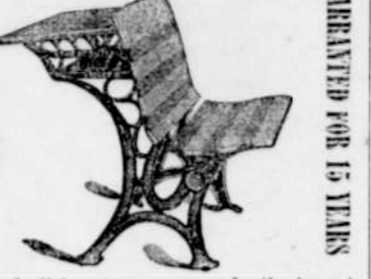
