LOCAL ITEMS.

There are 1165 patients in the insane asylum at Salem.

Mrs. Charley Hickox came up from Beaverton last Wednesday, on a visit to her sister, Mrs. Mynatt.

Geo. K. Rogers, organizer for the W. of W., will give a public lecture in Marshfield on the 19th of August, and will also visit Coquille.

The schooner Lila and Mattie arrived from San Pedro, southern California, last Wednesday, and is receiving a cargo of lumber at Lyons' mill for return.

Fifty cases of cans were delivered at the Timmons cannery on the lower river last Wednesday. They came via the bay and by train through this place last Wednesday morning.

From yesterday George Pike expected to increase his logging force to 30, and add another team of oxen. He has been getting out some fine spar timber, among other, and is rushed.

At Salem, July 31st, incorporation articles were filed from Marshfield by "The Marshfield Railway Transportation Co.; capital, \$20,000; incorporators, W. H. Noble, P. Hennessey and Richard H. Noble."

The cement arrived last Tuesday for flooring the basement of the new school building, and J. P. Goodman set to work instantly. The basement of our new school building will afford the equal in neatness, healthfulness, comfort and coziness of a sheltered playground of any in the state.

The school board at a late meeting chose Mrs. Inez Chaso as teacher of the second grade in our public school, making four teachers now, and a prospect of having to choose a fifth. The corps to date is: Prof. Claude Nosler, principal; Mrs. Inez Chaso, 1st intermediate; Miss Joe Beyers, 2d intermediate; Miss Pearl Fetter, primary.

Arrangements are about complete for a reopening of our collegiate institute. Prof. Ireland writes from Montana of his desire to take charge and conduct that school the coming year, and Rev. Futrell will attend to correspondence with those at a distance, or in other parts of Coos, Curry and Douglas counties, who may wish to attend, until Prof. Ireland arrives. Terms will be made known on application.

In the several cases taken under advisement by Judge Hamilton at close of last term of circuit court, opinions upon which are now received by County Clerk Reckleff and on file, we glean the following: J. H. James vs. Coos county, claim for back salary; ordered that case be dismissed and judgment be entered against James for costs. In the Dixon assignment case, John Bonewitz, assignee, ordered to distribute amount of funds on hand among creditors. Miller vs. Graham, no attorney's fee allowed against Graham.

Capt. Linbridge, of the schooner Lila and Mattie, arrived at this port last Wednesday, informs us of a narrow escape he made at the mouth of our river just as he departed, lumber-laden, the last trip. The steamer Columbia was passing on the outside, and ran across his bow despite his signals and efforts to avoid a collision. The Columbia, however, struck the schooner, and from the crash that followed Capt. Linbridge thought he must surely go down. The damage was considerable, though not as bad as feared, and we understand the captain has filed a statement with the authorities regarding the occurrence.

Coroner's Inquest.

Dr. Horsfall, coroner, was notified by Dr. Patterson, of Gardiner, on Thursday last, that Edward Hambidge, who was drowned at Temile on July 2d, was supposed to have met with foul play, and the coroner was requested to investigate the matter. Dr. Horsfall started for Temile next day and held an inquest, the testimony produced at which proved conclusively that deceased was accidentally drowned and there was no evidence whatever to show that he was the victim of foul play. The following composed the jury: John L. Quick, P. G. Jordan, Frank Bowron, Geo. Rhodes, Alex. Carlson, Albert Olson. After hearing the testimony they found "that he came to his death by accidental drowning in the waters of Black creek, North Lake, Coos county, Oregon."—Coos Bay News.

Dennis Donovan visited the coal mines at Rيفerton last week, where he met many old-time friends. He says there is a fine vein of coal at Rيفerton, but the mining men are badly handicapped in shipping to San Francisco.

Bert Tuttle, the boiler-maker, was in Marshfield Sunday. He has been engaged of late at Porter repairing the boilers, which he says are now in excellent condition.

W. L. Walker has located a 10-foot vein of coal on his Willaugh slough farm, from which he dug enough coal one afternoon last week to provide fuel to run his separator and for domestic purposes for four months to come.

E. G. Flanagan met with a painful accident this week while hanging up hams in his market. He was standing on a step-ladder, which slipped from under him and as he fell he grabbed a meat-hook and the sharp point inflicted an ugly gash in his left hand.

Several carloads of wool are at the railroad depot, awaiting the arrival of the Blanchard for shipment. The wool was brought here from Myrtle Point.

The Blanchard passed up the coast yesterday, with several hundred head of calves on board, which she was taking from Humboldt to Yaquina, to be pastured somewhere in that vicinity.

Frank Brown, who was hurt at James Cowan's camp, North Coos river, July 30, 1898, and who was sent to the city for treatment, died lately at the German hospital.

State Veterinary Surgeon MeLean arrived on the bay last week and inspected a herd of Guernseys on the upper J. A. Yoakam ranch. He found them suffering from consumption, and ordered seven head killed. The disease was brought here by imported cattle.

A large shark, measuring 12 feet in length, was found in shallow water by a party of picnickers at Rocky Point on Sunday.
