North Coquille in a Dilemma.

The dilemma, Mr. Editor, presents itself under different aspects. I propose to consider it in its aspect of the rights of a community to the unhindered enjoyment of a work of public utility to the making of which all have contributed by their money and their labor through many successive years.

The residents of North Coquille are this day debarred of every practical connection with the Coquille and Marshfield county road. This part of the road—which is now the bone of contention—has for a period of about eighteen years never been disputed by any one as a public property.

From a distance of two blocks from the Coquille city wharf—or, we will say from Mr. John Kronenberg's corner—as far as the northern line of North Coquille—a distance of a mile as the crow flies—there is not a practical approach to the Coquille and Marshfield county road from the East.
