Institute at Bandon.

Sept. W. H. Bunch called the annual Teachers' Institute in order about 1:30 p. m. Aug. 17, 1903.

On account of the teachers not all being present, after organization, the regular work was suspended and our two able instructors, Prof. Robinson, superintendent of Multnomah county, and Prof. D. A. Grout, of the Park school at Portland, gave some good general talks to the teachers. As is always the case their instructions and advice were received with approval as it is their own personal experience and observation, therefore we can rely upon it's being something practical and applicable.

Tuesday morning nearly every teacher in the county was present and all entered into the spirit of the work with the determination of deriving all the benefit they could for their school work. Many of the difficulties in geography were explained and the author's meaning made clear so that this usually dry subject may be made very interesting. Decimals and factors were made easy. The neglected points in reading were impressed upon our minds and we think there will be fewer found in the schools of Coos in the future. History, Civil Government, Grammar and other subjects were taken up and discussed to the benefit of our teachers.

Sept. Robinson brought forth in glowing colors the necessity of perfect cleanliness about our school rooms and the benefit derived from cleaning and beautifying the grounds.

The evening sessions with their recitations, songs, music and lectures, were both entertaining and instructive, and the good people of Bandon showed their appreciation of this galaxy of educators by crowding the hall full each evening.

In entertaining, who could surpass Captain Johnson of the tug, and his crew, who took us for a trip over the bar, the Life Saving boys, who so gallantly rowed those seventy-five school masters over the river, or the light house keeper, who so patiently explained everything to this crowd of fun and knowledge seekers.

The God of Wind withdrew his presence entirely, leaving Bandon calm and peaceful the entire week, and there is no place in the universe more desirable for a week's vacation than Bandon when she smiles.

Institute having closed Thursday evening, most of the teachers departed Friday morning, and as the Favorite steamed out with the co-operative army aboard, waving their handkerchiefs and singing "Goodbye Bandon," all felt that it was good to be there.
