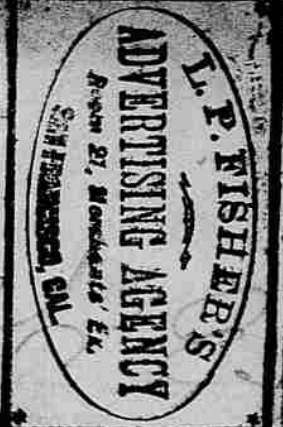

Pearl Page and Harding Indicted for Robbery.

ON TRIAL IN PORTLAND COURT  
Salem Third Party Men—They Nominate a Full Ticket—The Meeting Largely Attended.

Portland, March 16.—To-day trial of M. Harding, who was jointly indicted with Pearl Page for robbing G. Dickenson, commenced in the circuit court.
