A shortage there, while it is to be regretted, is already giving an upward tendency to the price in Oregon. The crop in Linn county is growing finely, with prospects of an abundant harvest.

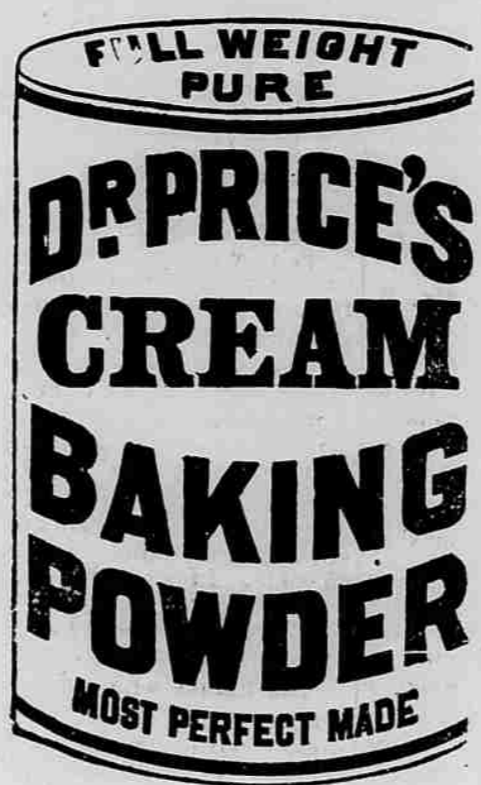
