Letters received from California, of recent date, state that the continued dry weather there is making sad havoc of the wheat crop. A shortage there, while it is to be regretted, is already giving an upward tendency to the price in Oregon. The crop in Linn county is growing finely, with prospects of an abundant harvest.
