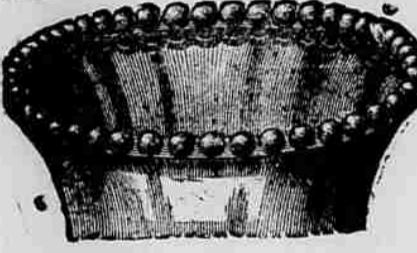


EUGENE UNIVERSITY.
