WEDNESDAY, JUNE 27.

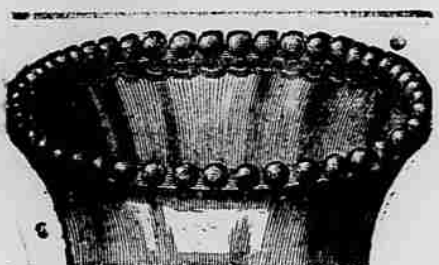
10 A. M.—Address before the literary societies by Hon. Geo. H. Burnett, of Salem.
