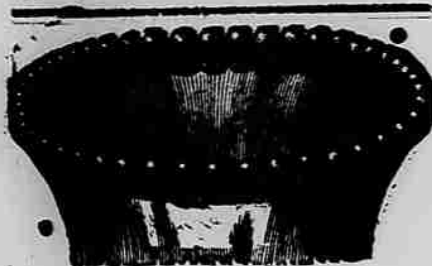


REGINA UNIVERSITY.

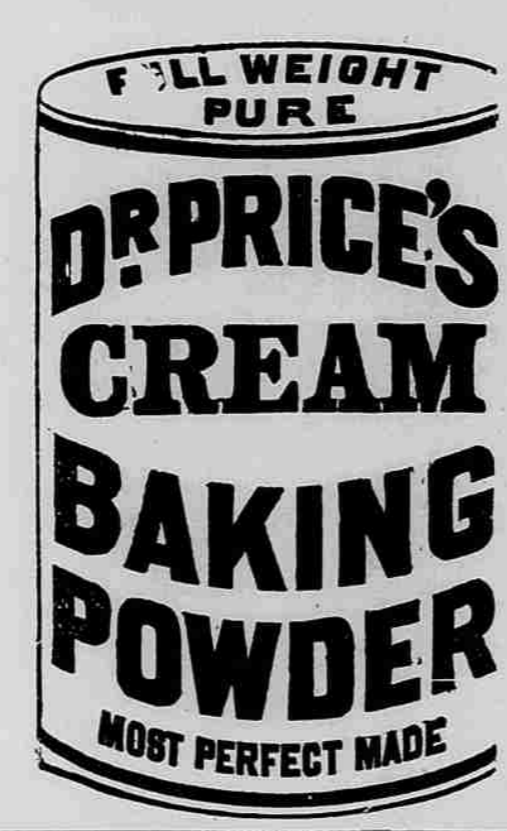

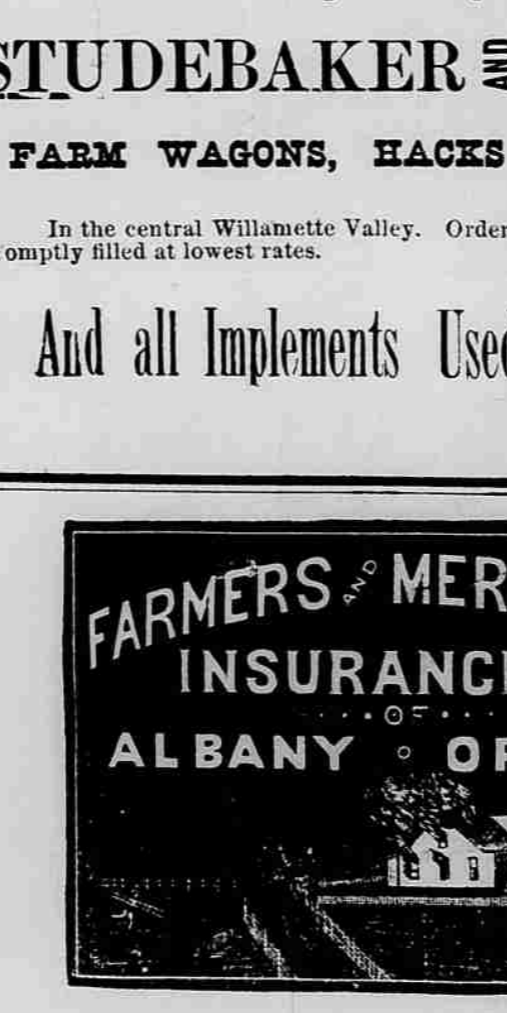
