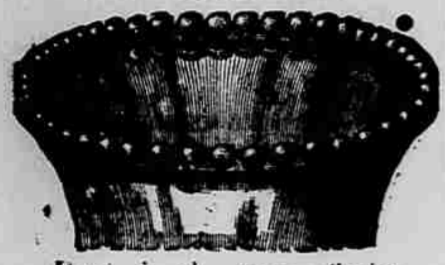


Xarifa Failing's Mother.
