SUFFRAGE WITHOUT LEARNING.

As an abstract question of political economy no one will question the soundness of the proposition to establish an educational qualification for voters.

The wisdom of adopting a measure of this kind will be a matter of considerable difference of opinion. Many will think as does the Chronicle that no one will question the fundamental principles of this bill, that is, no one who believes that diffused intelligence and general education are the safeguards of the liberties and prosperity of a free people.

They will probably also agree with the same paper that the proper way to reach this question is for the several states, in their capacity of sovereigns, to require that their citizens shall submit to an educational test before being permitted to exercise the right of suffrage; and when this is done, it will be entirely consistent for congress to adopt a similar provision with regard to aliens.

The fights and contests over land claims are numerous and vexatious, and very often result in putting into possession the parties not entitled in justice and equity to the lands.

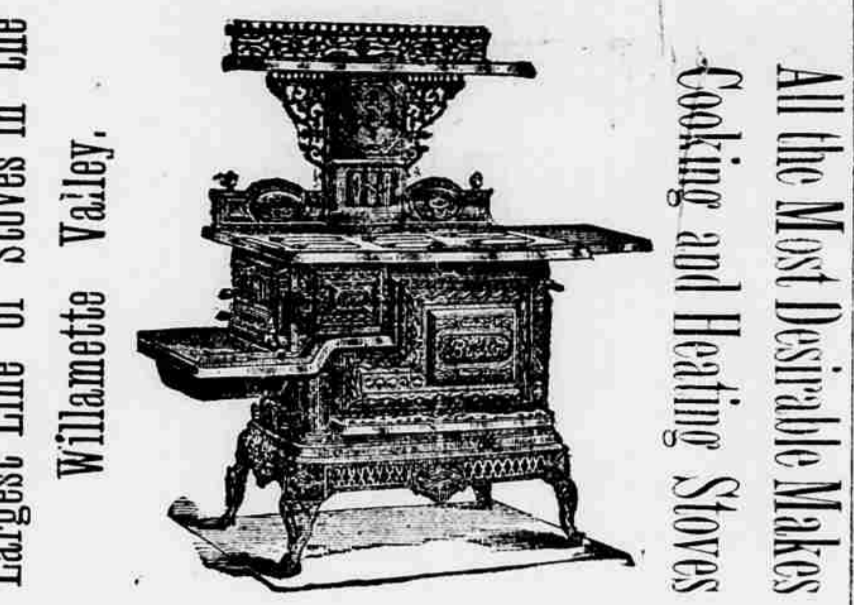
