AFRICAN SLAVE TRADE.

Abroad there is some discussion of a project of a great international expedition to destroy the slave-trade of the interior of Africa.

It has been suggested that England, Germany, and the other great powers of Europe should make a joint campaign against this "greatest shame of the nineteenth century."

In our country, with its large negro population, this subject, upon race considerations as well as upon grounds of humanity, is of peculiar interest.

Unfortunately, an incredulous and cynical world involuntarily smiles when any of the leading powers suggests a humanitarian programme like this for extirpating the African trade in slaves.

It is remembered too well that under this flag of humanity Great Britain has appropriated some of the fairest portions of the earth, making a pretended desire to promote civilization a cover for the lust of conquest.

Russia has used the same canting pretext for making several wars of conquest against the "barbarous Turk," and Russian armies are penetrating farther and farther into Asia in the assumed role of pioneers of civilization.

The Spaniards put to the sword the savages of this continent in the name of religion, and it has been observed that they were much more eager to secure the booty of the natives than to inculcate among them the doctrines of Christianity.

The Dutch, French, and Italians never cease to profess unbounded love for "humanity" when crushing barbarous races with bloody power and appropriating their territories.

Never have the European nations made more parade of their sentiments of philanthropy than when they were most affected by a thirst for colonial aggrandizement.

Now, since Stanley has penetrated into the dark interior of Africa, an expedition against the Mahdi, Tippu Tib, and other slave-trading kings would be quite feasible.

No question exists as to the importance and desirability of destroying this shameful traffic in men.

But it would be necessary first to adjust the material prizes of such a campaign. A love of humanity would be gratified in delivering the blacks from their cruel oppressors, but the powers would want something substantial in territorial acquisitions by way of indemnity for the dangers and expenses of this war in behalf of civilization.

The joint expedition would thus be likely to be wrecked in the outset in consequence of a difficulty in agreeing upon a division of the spoils.

Each of the nations of Europe will pursue its own methods of civilizing the barbarian world, and for this reason the Mahdi and Tippu Tib and the rest of the slave-dealing kings of Africa will have continued immunity.

The humanizing influence of peaceful commerce promise to do more to destroy this slave trade than a warlike crusade of the powers of Europe could possibly accomplish.

CONCERNING the attempt to change the school book series in Oregon again, there is but one sentiment among the people. They want no change.

The present school books may not be perfect, but the people in this case would rather bear the ills they have than fly to others they know not of, nor do they relish the idea of going down in their pockets for a new series of books at the whim of the syndicate of school book publishers.

AN interesting coincidence is found in the fact that the only two presidents who have been candidates for re-election and were beaten at the polls were Martin Van Buren, beaten in 1840 by William Henry Harrison, and Grover Cleveland, beaten in 1888 by Benjamin Harrison.
