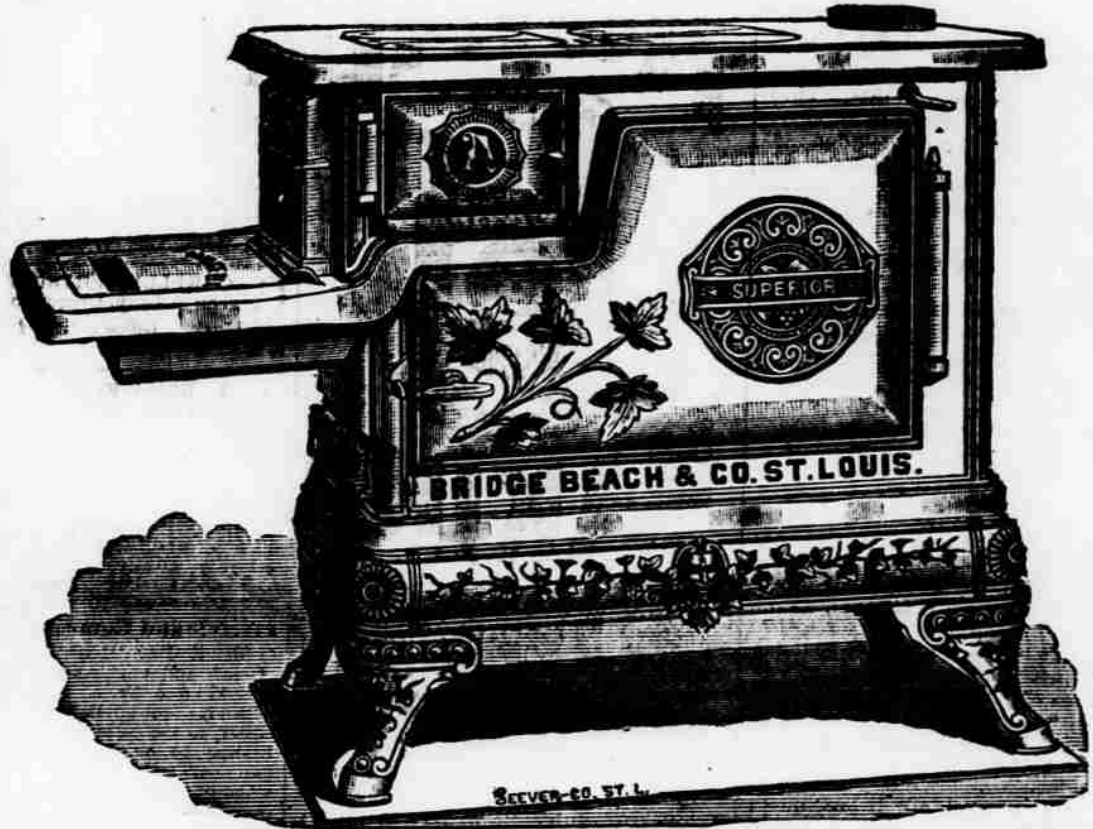

The Farmers National Alliance representing many states and territories, in annual session in Des Moines, Iowa, on the 10th ult. adopted the following: "Resolved, That we recommend the passage of such laws by the National government as will prohibit the manufacture and sale of all intoxicating beverages within the borders of the United States under a severe penalty."

In Oregon, Washington territory and Alaska, combined there are 1,852 dealers in distilled liquors, and 173 dealers in malt liquors, making a total of 2,034 dealers in intoxicating drinks. These figures are for the year 1888, and are taken from the report of the commissioner of internal revenue. It is shown from this report that Kansas, a prohibition state, makes not only the largest proportionate decrease in the number of "dealers" during the year, but has, also, followed by Iowa, by far the fewest in proportion to population, both states making at the same time a tremendous proportionate decrease in the production of liquors; while their high license rivals, Pennsylvania, Ohio and Missouri, show great gains in the total production of liquors. It must be remembered too that "liquor dealers" in prohibition states means not only every druggist or authorized agent who pays the government fee of \$25 to deal in spirits, but also every attempted violator of the state law who may have a government license in his possession, but who may not have sold a gallon of liquor in the state before his arrest as a law-breaker. A comparison, therefore, of "liquor-dealers" in prohibition and license states is obviously unfair to the former.

As it has been inserted in the Consular and Diplomatic bill appropriating \$100,000 for the payment of damages to the families of certain Japanese who were accidentally killed during the target practice of the United States man-of-war Onaha, in 1887. The principle is correct enough, but Japanese must be expensive, as there were only one or two killed, if we remember correctly, and a native but or two knocked down, and \$100,000 would pay for a whole village, so far as the houses are concerned. Human life is not so readily appraised, but it looks as though the senate were disposed to be too generous.

THE Cosmopolitan for January presents the succinct views of several of our prominent public men on the question of political union with Canada. Their opinions are as diverse as the opinions of their people. Judge Kelley, of Pennsylvania, and Congressman Butterworth, of Ohio, express themselves as emphatically in favor of union, and a paragraph from Senator Sherman's recent speech is quoted, in which he declares himself strongly to the same effect. Senator Ingalls, Speaker Carlisle, Congressman McCready, chairman of the house committee on foreign affairs; Senator Morgan, of Alabama, and Congressman Breckinridge, of Arkansas, also look on annexation favorably, but they are much more reserved and cautious in approving it. Senator Hiscock is flatly opposed to annexation at this time, though he adds that "conditions may arise in which it may be desirable." Congressman McKinley says that he is not prepared to make a suitable answer—"It is a large question, altogether too large to guess off." Major McKinley's attitude of indecision probably represents the feeling with which political union with
