RELATIVES' SPOUSE.

The slinger's wife. Mrs. John L. Sullivan, the legal wife of the prize-fighter, after listening to the persuasive eloquence of Captain Howland at Arctic became converted.

She heard of the Federal movements which threatened her "beloved South." She galloped by night to Stonewall Jackson and told him what she knew.

On a particularly daring expedition she was captured and sent to Washington. Here she became quite as much of a favorite with some of the young Federal officers.

After remaining some time in the old Capitol prison, in charge of William P. Wood, she was exchanged for the celebrated Colonel Michael Corcoran of the Irish brigade.

Soon afterward Jefferson Davis sent her some important dispatches to Great Britain. She sailed from Wilmington, N. C. May 8, 1864.

Soon afterward she crossed the ocean and created a great sensation when, on August 25, 1864, she married her captor, Lieutenant S. W. Harding in London.

On his death she married Colonel Hammond in 1880, who was then acting as traveling salesman. She then lived in Philadelphia.
