Owing to present indications there is not much hope of the saw mill men below here getting any logs this year. There is over 3,000,000 feet of logs above here now. The loggers are still camped about 10 miles above here waiting for the river to rise. I think they will have to abandon the plan of running logs down the river, and move there mills up to the timber. That would undoubtedly be the best plan, if we had a railroad through here. There is vast bodies of fine timber near here that has never been touched, which could be got out if there was a railroad in here. There is certainly great inducements for some company to build a branch road into this valley.

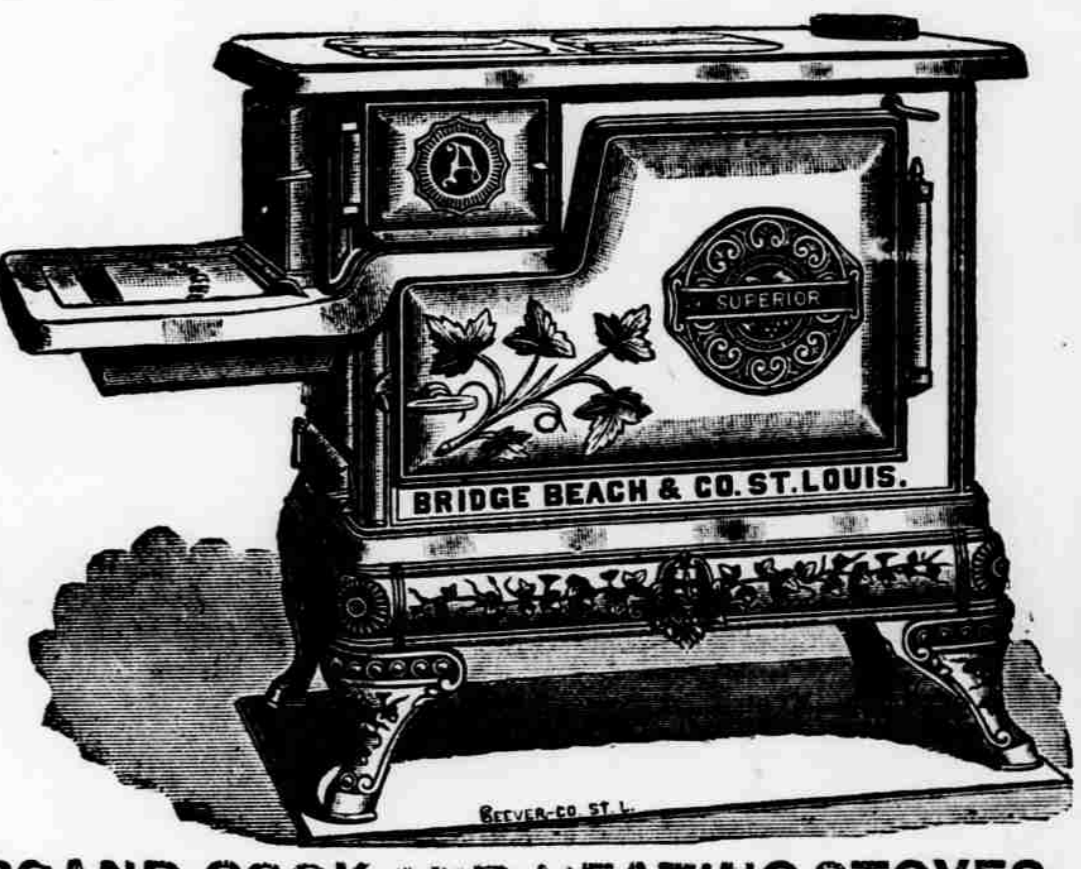
