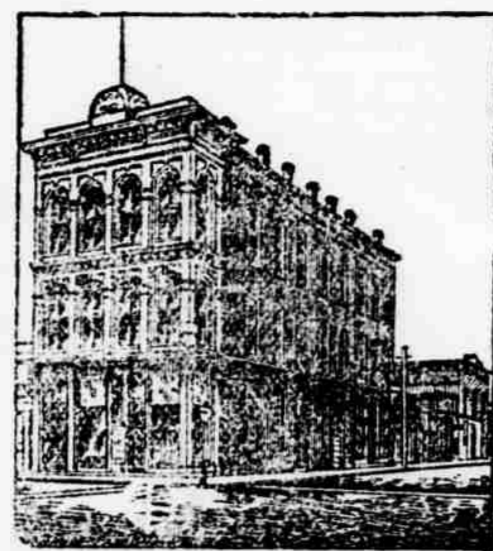

GENERAL NEWS.

Reported Renewal of Work on the Oregon Pacific.

SMALL FIRE AT THE CAPITAL. More Mormon Converts En Route to Utah To Investigate the British Spy System.

The Herald's Special Dispatches. SALEM, March 6.—Word received from the eastern part of this country says Engineer Eckelson has come to the front on the Oregon Pacific and that work will be resumed on the extension of that line very soon.

BRITISH SPIES. A Proposed Demand on the English Government.

PHILADELPHIA, March 6.—The Parnell branch of the Irish National League will this week submit to President Harrison and Secretary Blaine a resolution adopted by it this afternoon and will be sent every branch in the United States urging joint action by congress, requesting the state department to demand of the English government a statement of how it has carried on its spy system, military and otherwise, in this country.

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A HEAVY BLAST.

Ten Thousand Pounds of Powder exploded.

The Chronicle says the city received another great shock at 4:30 o'clock yesterday afternoon from the blasting process going on at Telegraph hill.

On the 25th of November they sent off a blast from which they counted between 40,000 and 50,000 tons of rock to the seawall.

Half an hour after the arrival of the powder at the quarry every pound of it—between 7000 and 10,000 pounds—was filed into three pits in the tunnel, one at the extreme end, about 130 feet from its mouth, and in two others at the end of drifts run inward from the main drift.

The tamping was finished at 4:15 o'clock yesterday afternoon. In about ten minutes after the work on the tunnel ceased, and everything pertaining was removed to a safe distance.

The blast cost the company nearly \$2000, including the expense of cutting the tunnel; but as nearly 30,000 tons of rock are to be pieces and ready for the seawall, they are elated at the result.

MRS. LOGAN'S GREAT SCHEME.

Establishing a Finishing School in the Arts of Housewifery. New York World.

It is said that Mrs. General Logan is busying herself abroad in looking into a scheme which she thinks—if she finds it practicable—of carrying into execution when she returns to this country.

In Germany there is a custom which sounds almost as if it were a survival from the Middle Ages, when boys were sent to the great families to be trained as pages, and girls learned to spin, sew, embroider, brew and bake under the supervision of a chaperone of a castle.

This custom, in its modern form, is to send girls, after they have finished school, to live a year in the household of some noted housewife, who teaches them all the accomplishments which it is held fitting a hausmutter should a quire Ma. y women in Germany who are learned in all domestic matters, but who are left widowed and in need of money, keep their homes in this way.

They take as inmates young ladies, who are given a year of training in house-keeping. They are taught all the mysterious of washing paint so that it will not peel, of sweeping carpets so that the nap is not taken away with the dust.

They learn how floors should be waxed to look like glass, and old mahogany polished to resemble a mirror, how silver should be cleaned and china and glass properly washed; what will cleanest cleanest and brighten mirrors and windows; how lamps are kept in order, and what is the secret of properly laundered linen.

They learn how to market, to choose the best meat, fish and vegetables, and how they should be cooked to be tender and well flavored. Their pastry falls into flavoured, their breads and rolls are light and sweet.

They know how to can, preserve and bottle all sorts of vegetables and fruits, and just how tables should be set, dinners served, and wines cooled. They know the art of bed-making, dusting, packing, arranging closets, and regulating servants' work, and they are taught all the important rudiments of needlework.

At the end of the year to run a house economically, liberally and with oiled wheels warranted not to squeak. This is the system Mrs. Logan is making a study, and her idea is to found just such a home in this country, where girls can take a post-graduate course of a year, learning all these important accomplishments, which would go far towards negotiating in many homes the suggestion that marriage is a failure.

She thinks, it is safe, of founding the home in Chicago, and already some twenty young ladies have promised to begin with her. She does not propose to make the year all work and no play. The home is to be a by-hand-one home, fitted with every comfort, supplied with books and music, and the girls are to find that part of the curriculum is in learning through practical experience's how to entertain in every fashion.

Mrs. Logan is a woman of great energy and executive ability, and if she undertakes this project she may be trusted to carry it out with beneficial results.
