OUR WAR VESSELS. The dispatches related a few days ago with some air of pride

Great Britain has not been idle during the past year. The Nile, a turret ship of 11,940 tons displacement

France has launched one armored battle-ship of 10,480 tons displacement and one armored coast defense vessel of 1610 tons.

Germany has added to her naval fleet two fourteen-knot cruisers, each of 1300 tons, and four torpedo boats of 250 tons each.

Italy has launched ten vessels of 18,817 tons displacement, and is building eighteen vessels of 30,701 tons.

Spain has launched an iron fourteen-knot cruiser of 1152 tons, and has in course of construction six belted cruisers of 7000 tons each.

Even Austria, Sweden, Portugal, Holland and Turkey have added to their respective navies, while the United States, with an enormous sea-coast to protect, a vast commerce to care for, and an overflowing treasury to draw upon

It is time for us to build something besides swift cruisers. Once in a while a war ship has something to do besides running away, and naval warfare cannot be confined to commerce destroying.

William W. Thomas, jr., of Maine, minister to Norway and Sweden. Whitelaw Reid, of New York, to be minister to France.

Julius Goldsmith, of Wisconsin, to be consul-general at Vienna.
