The Nashville American recently devoted two pages to the report of the unveiling of the splendid monument to the Confederate dead at Nashville, Tenn.

It is absolutely certain that there never can be a revival of the attempt to have a division of the United States of America upon any lines like unto those between the Confederate and Federal governments.

Mr. Breckinridge added that whatever there was in the future for the South is indissolubly interwoven with the union of the states and that for the south and her problems there is no safety but in the continuity of an indestructible union.

This is a manly, just, and fair conception of the relations of the states, and if this sentiment prevailed everywhere, as it must in the near future, we shall hear no more of sectionalism and have none of the intemperate talk, either in the North or the South, that has only added fuel to the expiring flames of sectional feeling.

It was a happy idea to assemble, at the same table, the special envoys of each of these democratic nations, that they might compare notes, congratulate each other on the manifold success of the republican experiment, and render homage to the anniversary of the great French Revolution.
